Footnote 2

To prophesy is to speak for God and to speak forth God under His direct revelation. Prediction may be included in prophecy, but it is not the main aspect of the prophecy mentioned here. Prophesying brings in God's revelation for the building up of the church, the Body of Christ (1 Cor. 14:4b). These three — prophecy, teaching (v. 7), and exhortation (v. 8) — are related and coordinate with one another. The one who prophesies speaks what he has received as a direct revelation from God. The one who teaches instructs others, not based on direct revelation but based on what the prophets have spoken. He who exhorts does so according to both the direct speaking under God's revelation and the teaching that is according to this revelation. These three kinds of speaking are for the building up of the Body. They minister the life supply to the saints that they may grow together by God's word.

LETTERS TO HOUSTON

Dearest ones,

As can be expected, the newness of the city of Boston and this extension training are wearing off, and the real training has definitely begun. I'm foreseeing that the emails I send from XB will be shorter, more related to my experiences, and have more pictures.

I'm seeing more and more how important prayer is, both personally for our going on with the Lord and in our working with others to bring them further in the Lord as well. The way I've heard it recently is that prayer is really the "heavy lifting" relative to our time taking care of others. It makes sense; we're those cooperating with God, not as ones initiating so many things. He operates, and we cooperate.

I'm also sensing more and more how necessary it is to keep short accounts with the Lord and with others. The way Paul put it in Acts: Having a conscience void of offense before God and man. This gives us the boldness before God in our fellowship with Him, giving us a clear sky to go on by His supplying us with Himself for our living and work.

The more I get anxious and worried about how my times go with students, the more I realize that I'm living and serving in the wrong realm; what I'm apart of is the Lord's business, His enterprise, and His economy. I'm just a steward, which means my duty is to dispense the unsearchable riches of Christ (Ephesians) and allow God to cause the growth (1 Corinthians). The results are almost secondary; it's His business.

Maybe more subjective and deep than all this, is my realization that I need to be broken. Watchman Nee talks about this in great detail in the book, *The Breaking of the Outer Man for the Release of the Spirit*. It's helpful to go back and read Jacob's account in Genesis. He started out as such a conniver, a supplanter, arranging things to go his way again and again. And eventually, at Peniel, God appeared to him, wrestled with him, and gave him a substantial experience of breaking.

In our experience today, this is for us to release the Lord from within us, that people would touch the Lord's life in us in all we do and say. Our soul-life would no longer be in the way; the Spirit (in and with our human spirit) could freely flow God to others.

As usual, please give me an update of your own! It's good for me to know how others are doing to not get so wrapped up in my own things.
