Ex 16:15 And when the children of Israel saw it, they said to one another, 'What is it? For they did not know what it was. And Moses said to them, It is the bread which Jehovah has given you to eat.

Although it is known that manna came from heaven (v. 4), the element and essence of manna are a mystery. Manna did not belong to the old creation; nevertheless, it could nourish man's physical body. Thus, it must have contained certain elements and minerals that were a part of the old creation. As the real manna, Christ also is mysterious. In resurrection He became the life-giving Spirit (1 Cor. 15:45), yet He has a body that can be seen and touched (Luke 24:36-43). Thus, it is difficult to say whether Christ is spiritual or material.

LETTERS FROM THE SAINTS

Dear Saints in Houston,
Greetings from the church in Salt Lake City. The church life here is very precious, and we are full of thanks to the Lord for all of His arrangements and for His placing us according to His will. Last week we had a local blending conference in SLC with roughly 95 saints attending from AZ, CA, CO, ID, NV, UT, and WY. The messages covered the Development of the Kingdom of God. We particularly enjoyed the keys to shutting up the gates of Hades and ushering in the Kingdom of God (denying the self, taking up the cross, and losing the soul-life). To take up the cross is simply to say amen to God's will. May we all enter in to follow the pattern of our lovely forerunner and take God's will in every circumstance without murmuring or reasoning but with thanksgiving.

The saints here are burdened for the increase and spread of the testimony of Jesus. In recent prayer meetings, we have prayed for the Lord to populate lampstands in many cities in the state of Utah. Utah is the state having the youngest population with an average age of 31 years old. The numbers of children and young people are massive, something that we have never seen elsewhere. Three universities around where we live (BYU, Utah Valley University, University of Utah) host over 100,000 college students. Utah has been among the top ranks in economic growth in recent years, with many new jobs and many people moving in from out of state. None of this is an coincidence. Dear Lord, your name be sanctified; Your kingdom come; Your will be done!

The number of saints that gather on the Lord's day is 20+ to 30+. Quite a few among these 20-30 have been moved by the Lord to Utah in recent years. The Lord has burdened the saints to sell the meeting hall for quite some time, and just this past month it was sold. We are now before the Lord seeking His will for where the church would meet. Please pray for this and may the Lord do superabundantly above all that we could ask or think.

Although the saints in this region are very spread out, they are exercised to regularly blend with the localities from the surrounding states, and we warmly extend an invitation to the saints in Texas to visit, blend, and enjoy the body life. As for us, we think of you often and miss you dearly. You are on our hearts and in our prayers. Sometimes we are filled with joy just thinking of you saints - the church is God's masterpiece and preciousness itself.

AN INTRODUCTION TO MINISTRY DIGEST
